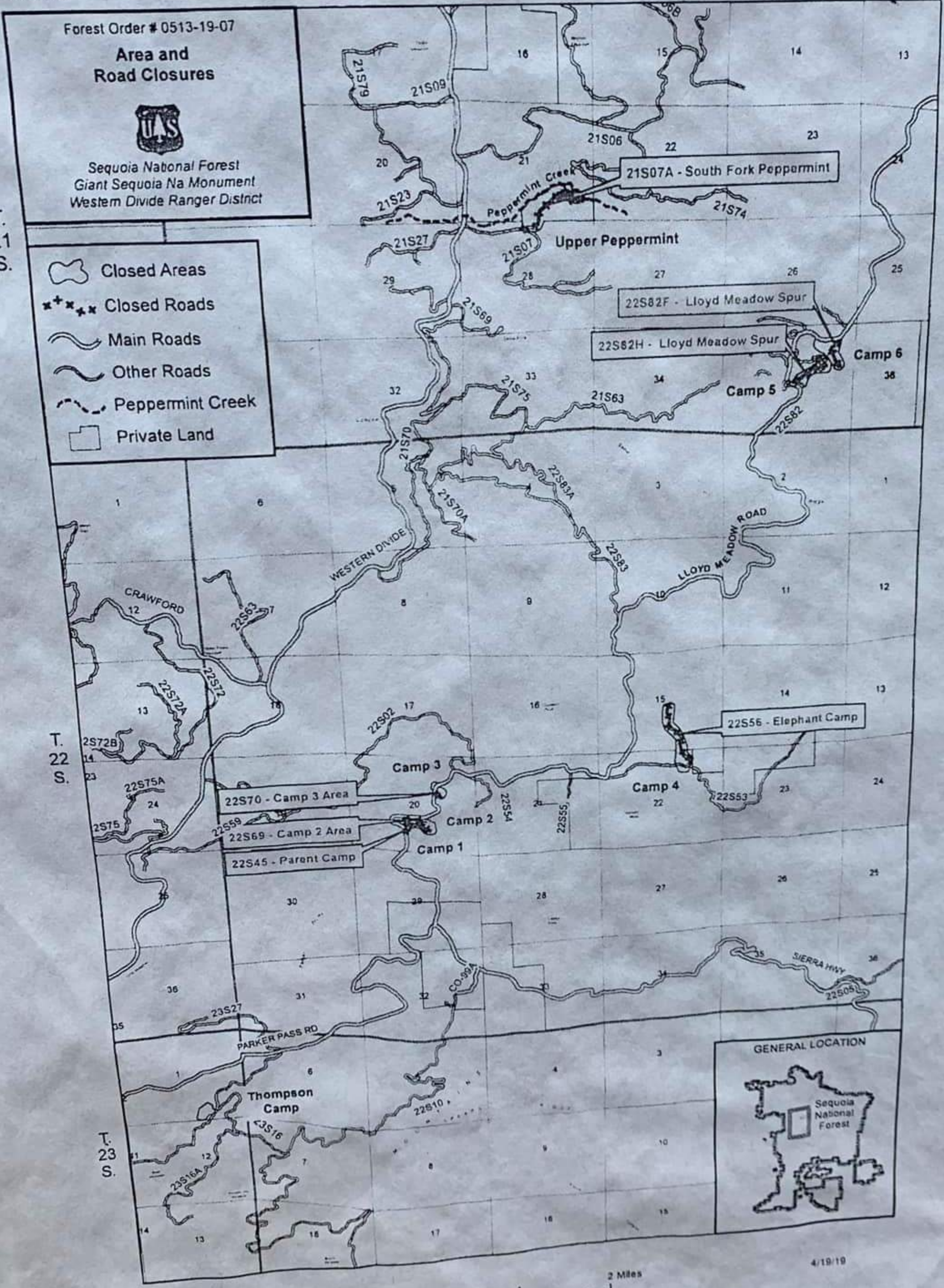

FOREST ORDER NO. 0513-19-07
SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST
WESTERN DIVIDE RANGER DISTRICT

AREA AND ROAD CLOSURES

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Western Divide Ranger District in the Sequoia National Forest. This Order is effective from May 1, 2019 through November 30, 2019.

1. Being upon National Forest System lands within the following dispersed camping areas, as shown on Exhibit A.

- a. Thompson Camp
- b. Camps 1, 2, 3, 4, and 6
- c. Camp 5. The Camp 5 dispersed camp closure includes all land within 200 feet to the southeast of South Peppermint Road (Forest Road No. 22S82H) from its intersection with Lloyd Meadow Road (Forest Road No. 22S82) then northeast for approximately ½ mile.
- d. Upper Peppermint. The Upper Peppermint dispersed camp closure area begins at the intersection of South Fork Peppermint Road (Forest Road No. 21S07) and South Fork Peppermint Spur (Forest Road No. 21S07A) in Section 28, Township 21 South, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues northeast at a distance of 150 feet from South Fork Peppermint Road parallel to South Fork Peppermint Road to its intersection the south section line of Section 21, then continues due east along the section line to its intersection with the southeast corner of Section 21, then continues north along the eastern section line to a point approximately 50 feet south of Peppermint Creek, then continues west at a distance of 50 feet south of Peppermint Creek parallel to Peppermint Creek for approximately .75 miles to a point due north of the intersection of South Fork Peppermint Road and South Fork Peppermint Spur, then continues due south back to the starting point.

2. Being on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown in Exhibit A.

- a. South Fork Peppermint Spur Road (Forest Road No. 21S07A)
- b. South Peppermint Road (Forest Road No. 22S82H) starting 0.3 mile southeast of the intersection with Lloyd Meadow Road (Forest Road No. 22S82) then continuing southwest to its terminus.
- c. Peppermint Falls Road (Forest Road No. 22S82F)
- d. Parent Camp Road (Forest Road No. 22S45)
- e. Camp 2 Area Road (Forest Road No. 22S69)
- f. Camp 3 Area Road (Forest Road No. 22S70)
- g. Elephant Camp Road (Forest Road No. 22S56)


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
